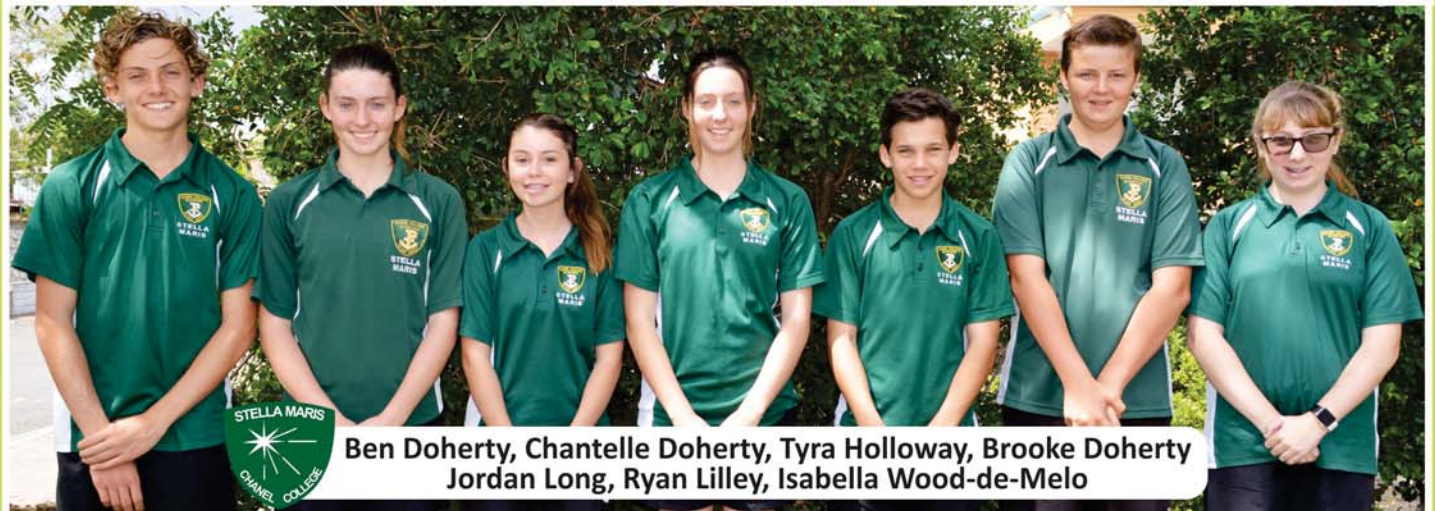

From Saturday 10 October to Monday 12 October it was my pleasure to attend the 'Teacher Professional Development Rock Tour 2015'. This marvellous event is sponsored by The Queensland Minerals & Energy Academy (QMEA) and BHP Billiton Mitsubishi Alliance (BMA).

This unique, hands-on opportunity increased my understanding of the Earth & Environmental Science as well as Science as a Human Endeavour strand. Our tour guide was a Senior Geologist – Exploration from BMA who held our interest with his knowledge and passion for Geology. With this information I will be able to add more relevant information to my teaching and also impart this knowledge to other teachers at the College.

These are just some of the topics we covered and experienced firsthand; geological timescales, rock cycle, types of rocks, sapphire formation, volcanic plugs and coal formation. On site at Goonyella Riverside Mine we were exposed to the working environment in the areas of exploration drilling, explosives drilling, earth moving using draglines, coal transportation onsite, the control room (coal movement and high wall monitoring using infrared cameras, coal blending).

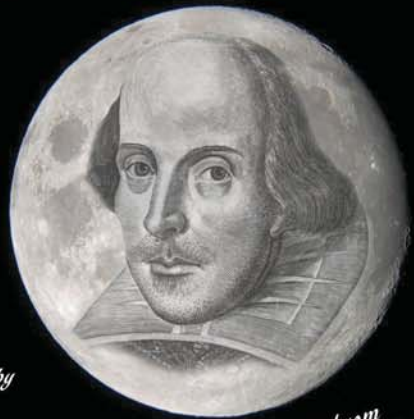
