The Cathedral will continue to need work done to it in the future. Donations to the Cathedral Conservation Appeal can be made at any time, but one way of contributing to the Appeal is to use the Drakes Community Dollars program Key Tags when shopping at Drakes Supermarkets which means that one cent for every dollar spent is donated back to the Cathedral Appeal. 
