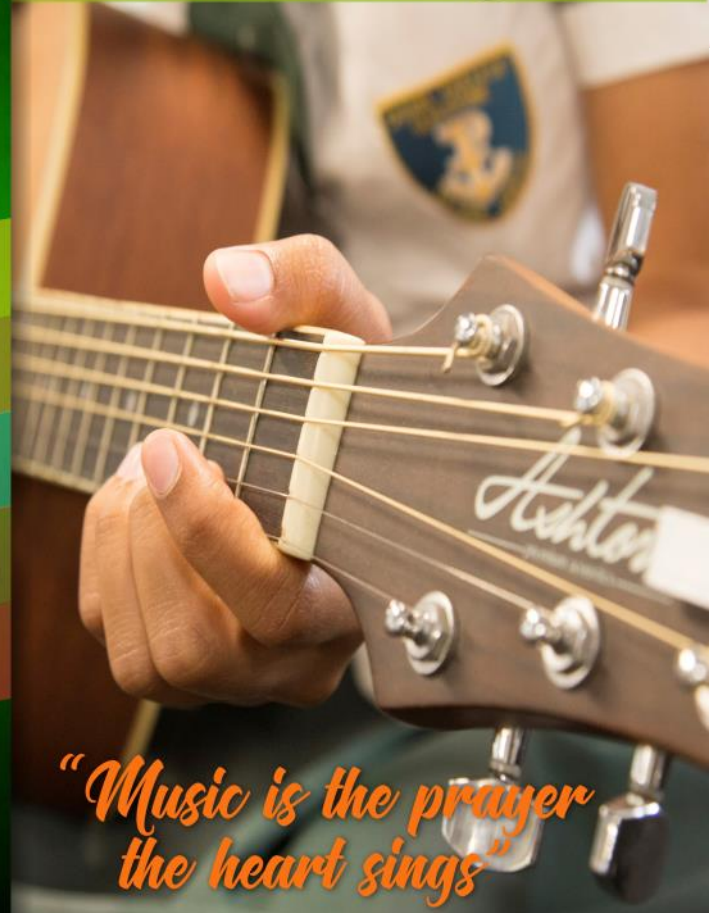

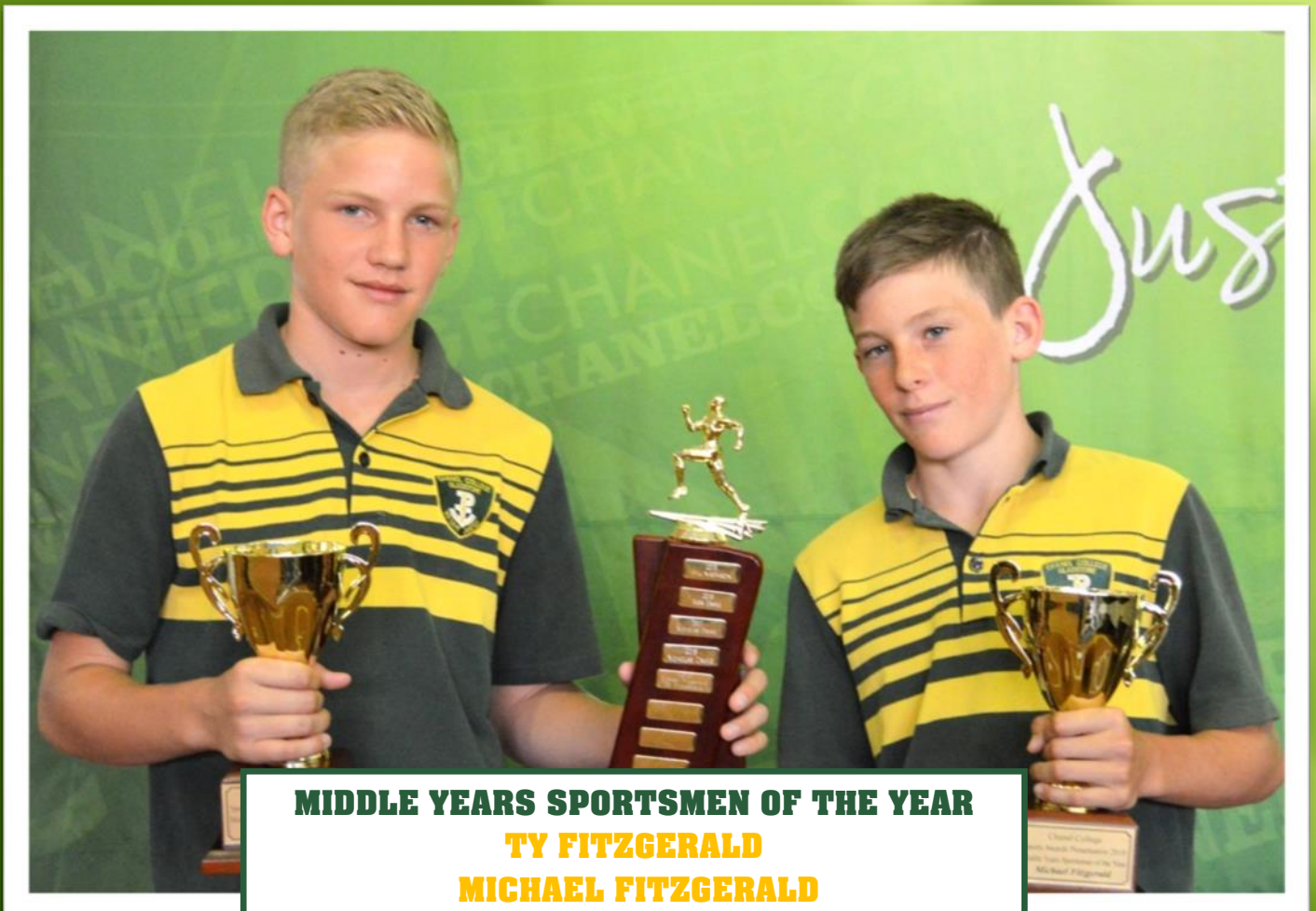

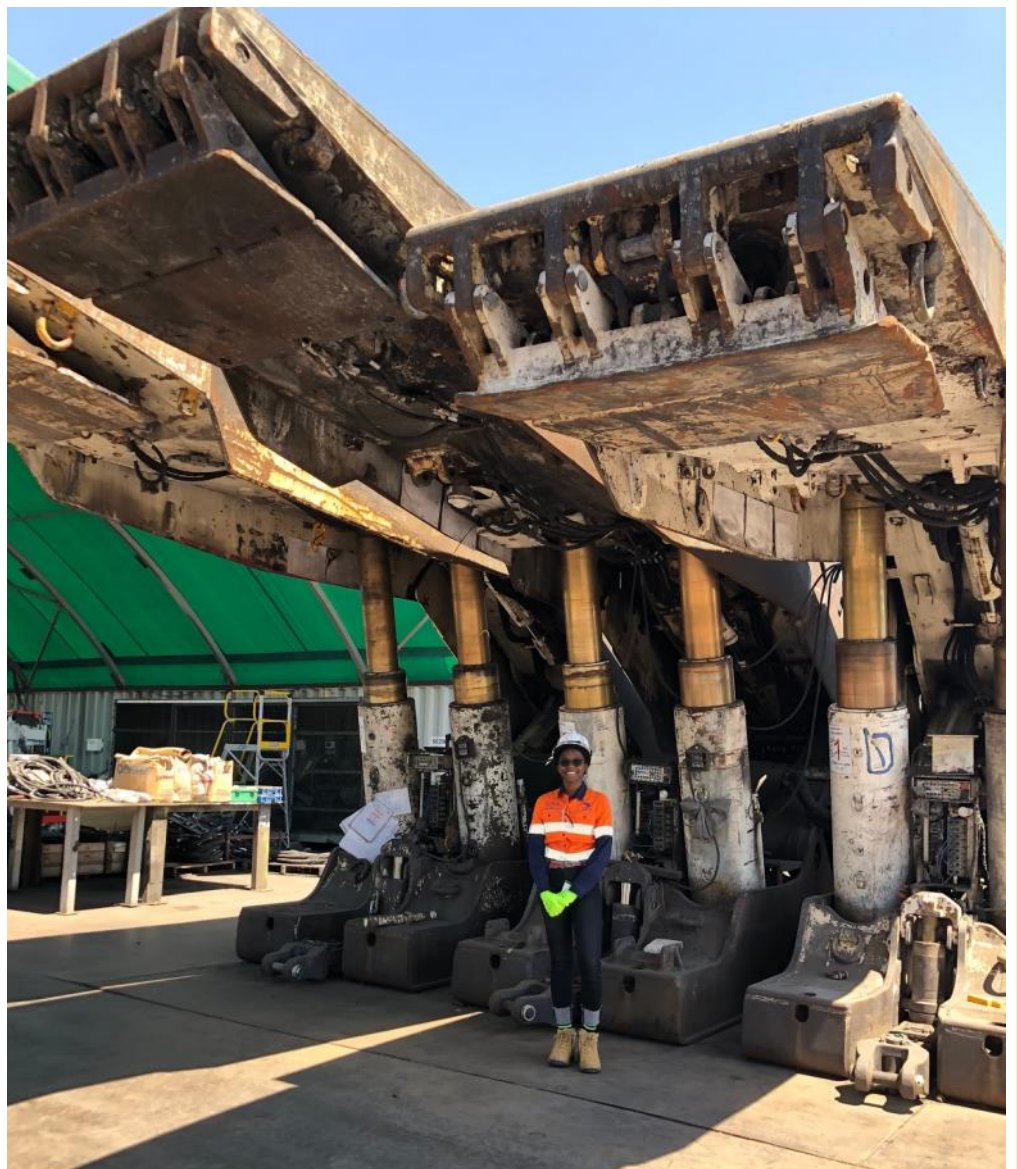


## QMEA Mine Challenge 2019
