Policy Statement

Description

PREAMBLE:

St Joseph's School as part of the Catholic diocese of Rockhampton strives to become a community of learning for all aspects of life in Church and society. It has a particular concern for justice and charity in a climate of mutual respect for self and others.

VALUE STATEMENT

Implementation Issues

Parents will be informed about recurring behaviour problems and involved in the collaborative process to develop strategies for the solution of these problems. Counselling may be at the request of the school or parents.
