At St Joseph's school, the tuckshop provides a service to the school community, as a non-profit enterprise.

Description

PREAMBLE St. Joseph's School Wandal Tuckshop provides a range of nutritional food to the school

community in the spirit of service and justice.

RATIONALE This policy is created out of a sense of social responsibility to the school community. It

ensures that the school tuckshop will provide a range of healthy and wholesome foods

for those who wish to access it.

VALUES Service to those in need.

Social responsibility - parents to children, parents to parents, children to children, staff

to staff, staff to parents, staff to children.

Spirit of co-operation.

Community care and support in hospitality.

Implementation Issues

- 1. The tuckshop will provide foods of good nutritional value and offer a variety of choices.
- 2. To ensure the smooth running of the tuckshop, the convenor will be assisted by voluntary help from the school community, both in serving and cooking.
- 3. The tuckshop will be opened to provide for first and second break.
- 4. The highest standards of hygiene will be maintained in food preparation and handling and the storage of hot foods will be at the recommended temperatures.
- 5. Because the tuckshop is a non-profit making enterprise, the cost of foods will be kept at a break-even point.
- 6. The convenor will need to liaise with the school principal and P&F with regards to matters of general maintenance, costing and upkeep of the tuckshop.
